

Daily Waste Collection Updates

Tuesday 9 February

Following further snowy & icy conditions overnight, **today's collection services have been suspended**. Our trucks weigh up to 32 tonnes and before sending them out, we have to consider the risk of injury to the public and staff, damage to property and the possibility of becoming stuck, causing further disruption.

Please leave your bins out readily available for when the crews return to catch up when it is safe to do so. Crews will be working over the weekend if necessary to catch up with collections.

Staff have been redeployed to assist KCC Highways with gritting activities to help keep access to essential services open, as well as working over the weekend to catch up with this week's collections.
