The initial assessment of a complaint (which will apply equally where a Councillor self-refers a matter to me) would ordinarily be undertaken by me as Monitoring Officer, in consultation with the Independent Person(s) and the Chairman & Vice-Chairman of the Joint Standards Committee. However, given my previous involvement in raising with you the allegations now giving rise to the referral, I shall be appointing an external person to fulfill the role of Monitoring Officer in this case.

As your alleged conduct is the subject of a referral to the Joint Standards Committee, you are entitled to seek the views of one of the appointed Independent Persons in accordance with the provisions of Section 28 of the Localism Act 2011. Should you wish to contact an Independent Person, please let me know and I will ask either John Gledhill or David Ashton (our appointed Independent Persons) to get in touch.
